Thousands of people have signed up for Readers Club over the last four years, and collectively they have logged nearly 100,000 books!



HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN READERS CLUB

To participate in Readers Club, you must:

- Create a Beanstack account: Signing up is easy and can be done by visiting any LPL branch or going to www.mypli.info
- Read or listen to any book: There are no reading requirements, so read or listen to any book you want!
- Log your book: Don't forget to log any books you read into your Beanstack account, because this is how we keep track of everyone's progress!

Registration for Readers Club is officially open!



MONTHLY CHALLENGE

Along with reading or listening to books of their choosing, Readers Club participants may also complete Monthly Challenges based on a particular theme!

Here's how you can complete a Monthly Challenge:

- Read one (1) book pertaining to that month's theme
- Log in to your Beanstack account
- Log your associated book on the Activity Badge for the month (logging must take place within the dates for the badge to earn it)



