2025 SRP CHALLENGE OVERVIEW

Get ready for a summer of fun and reading with four exciting challenges for all ages!

Registration for the Library's Summer Reading Program officially opens Monday, May 19, through our Summer Reading page on Beanstack. Your age group will determine which challenge you can participate in.

Once you complete your challenge, visit your local branch to claim your completion prize! But be sure to keep reading to earn more entries in our end-of-summer grand prize drawings.

SRP AGE GROUPS

Read-To-Me (Ages 0-5)

To complete the challenge, you must earn 10 points by reading and logging 10 picture books.

Youth (Ages 6-12)

To complete the challenge, you must earn 3 points by reading and logging 3 chapter books or 180 minutes of reading.

Teen (Ages 13-18)

To complete the challenge, you must earn 3 points by logging 3 chapter books, 180 minutes of reading, 3 activities, or a mix of all three.

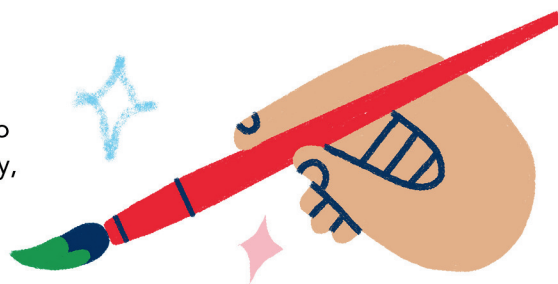
Adult (Ages 18+)

To complete the challenge, you must earn 3 points by logging 3 chapter books, 180 minutes of reading, 3 activities, or a combination.
