





Livingston Parish Library branches were open **15,117 hours to the public**.




The library reported **85,033 registered borrowers** this year–65% more than the 45,901 borrowers reported five years ago.




Our reference librarians answered 66% MORE questions in 2016 than in 2011. They answered **149,379 questions** total.

Adult Literacy

- 15% of parish residents (14,586 people) function below a basic literacy level. (2010 Census)
- Livingston Parish Library responded by creating the <u>first adult literacy program in the parish</u> helping ages 18 and up improve their reading skills. In 2016, the library hired an adult literacy specialist to run the program.
