

# Capital Projects Plan FY 2021



### Introduction

Livingston Parish Library Board of Control recognizes the value of the public's investment in the parish-wide library system. It is also the Board's responsibility to protect this investment by maintaining library facilities in the most prudent, respectful manner, thus, ensuring that the library continues to serve its community for many years to come.

Capital improvements require careful planning and timely allocation of funds. Livingston Parish Library pays for projects by dedicating three to four percent of its annual revenue. The FY2021 Capital Projects Plan identifies numerous capital expenses, which include building repairs, improvements, computer upgrades, and vehicle purchases. This document also provides a recommended schedule for future expenditures their estimated cost, which are listed at the end of this message.

### FY 2021 Projects

### 1. Roofing Shingles Replacement, Main Branch

It is widely accepted that architectural shingles are rated to last 25-30 years before they need to be replaced. However, in our experience, most of the roofing shingles at the branches failed in the first 10-13 years. As of August 2020, the Main branch is due for roof replacement because of the deteriorating shingles. The warranty claim has been submitted to the manufacturer. However, if the claim is denied, the library will incur the expense of repairs, which are estimated at \$70,000.

### 2. Computer Upgrades, System-Wide

Livingston Parish Library offers its patrons free access to public computers, Office applications, and fast access to the Internet. A typical industry warranty covers computer repairs and replacements for five years since the date of the purchase. In 2021, most of the staff and public computers will have reached the end of their warranty period. A system-wide upgrade will allow the library to replace up to 250 computers at an estimated total cost of \$300,000. The upgrade will also include the underlying server and management infastructure to support the new system. The library is currently obtaining quotes for the upgrade. A more detailed proposal will be submitted to the Board in the first quarter of 2021.

### 3. Vehicle Purchases

The library owns several vehicles that are used for business purposes. The oldest vehicle was purchased in 2009 and has become unreliable and unsafe to operate; it needs to be replaced. The library administration would also like to purchase a vehicle specifically for building maintenance needs due to the new Facility Maintenance Technician position being added in 2020. Both vehicles will be purchased by using the Louisiana State Contract at the cost of approximately \$25,000 each.

### 4. LED Retrofit, Watson Branch

The cost of maintaining fluorescent bulb fixtures is increasing due to frequent bulb failures, the shortage of ballasts, and the labor cost associated with the frequent repairs. The library administration would like to retrofit the Watson branches with newer, more energy-efficient, longer-lasting LED fixtures. The projected cost of upgrades is \$35,000.

### 5. Study Rooms

Based on the increasing demand for meeting/study spaces, the administration would like to add study rooms at the Albany-Springfield, Watson, and South branches. The cost of adding these amenities will have to be formally confirmed by an architect, but should not exceed \$110,000.

### 6. Additional Storage Space

The administrative location serves as the main hub for the system-wide distribution of programming supplies. The increasing programming needs require additional storage space. In addition, the area may include three additional offices. The existing storage space will be retrofitted to provide workspaces and cubicles for future hires. The approximate cost of construction is \$464,000.

The projects listed below cover the completed (2017-2020) and future projects (through 2033). The 2021-2033 plan also includes future branch construction as an option. The Livingston Parish Administration is conducting a Community Needs Assessment to determine the need for new library locations.

### **Summary**

Thanks to the current Plan and the adopted Pay-As-You-Go (PAYGO) approach of managing reserves, the library was able to complete 40 capital projects between 2017-2020, which totaled to \$1,206,701. By following the existing strategy of managing revenue, the Livingston Parish Library system will be able to accomplish its goals without approaching the voters for millage increases or long-term financing of the project through bonds.
